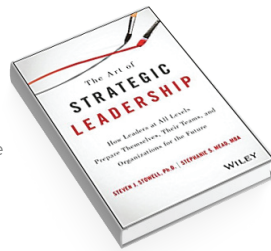


## 1. The Art of Strategic Leadership

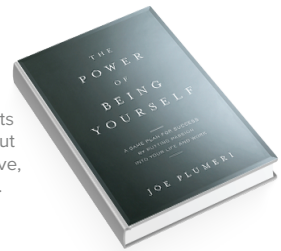


## 2. The Power of Being Yourself

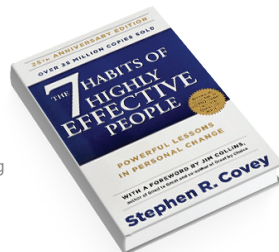


## 3. 7 Habits of Highly Effective People
